Your Itinerary

1. Arrive Norman Manley International Airport, Kingston pm. Transfer to the Greencastle Estate overlooking Robins Bay. Dinner & overnight stay at this charming guesthouse.
2. After an early breakfast you can opt to:
 - a) Be driven into the Blue Mountains and then climb to visit a Blue Mountain coffee estate near Hardware Gap through a trail banked by wild & exotic flowers that prefer cooler climates and on clear days offers grand vistas of the mountains & valleys.
 - b) Hike from Charles Town to the ruins of an C18th Coffee estate and learn all about the very interesting history of the Maroons along the way. Enjoy a rustic lunch picnic style and visit the small museum at Charles Town to gain insights into Maroon history.

Evening transfer to Hotel Mocking Bird Hill, 2010 Responsible Tourism Winners, Best Hotel For the Environment for 3-course dinner and overnight stay.

3. After a leisurely breakfast you'll be driven to the Rio Grande Valley for a short hike through this lush valley to McKenzie waterfalls. Your community guide will also be your raft's captain.

Lunch can be arranged either on the riverside at the charming Miss Betty's or at the local village "pub" after your return from McKenzie Falls.

The afternoon will be spent rafting down the Rio Grande River, on a bamboo raft that traditionally shipped bananas from the interior to the coast.

Dinner and 2nd overnight at Mocking Bird Hill.

4. Try a traditional Jamaican breakfast and then leave for an invigorating River walk to Reach Falls. Enjoy a "natural" massage under the falls and explore the hidden cave behind the falls. Your local guide will show you where to walk along the rocks and then swim across the pools.

On your return you can either stop at Boston for some traditional jerk or come back to have lunch at Mocking Bird Hill and then depart for the airport following a late checkout.
